

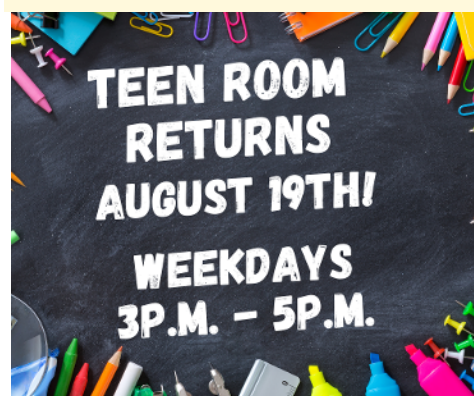

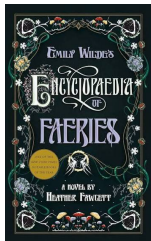
Also on tap for August are beach reads, books by well-known authors, and world history books.
